ELEMENTS OF RISK

Educational activity programs, such as a trip to Alberta Legislature Field Trip, involve certain elements of risk. Injuries may occur while participating in these activities. The following list includes, but is not limited to examples of the types of injury which may result from leaving the school grounds.

1. Traffic accidents that may occur while traveling by bus to and from Edmonton.

2. Pedestrian injuries that may occur while walking to/from the bus to/from the Alberta Legislature.

3. Personal injuries that may occur while participating in the activities at Alberta Legislature, such as: dehydration, falling on uneven ground/flooring/steps, bruising, spraining of ankle, broken bones, allergic reactions, etc.

The risk of sustaining these types of injuries result from the nature of the activity and can occur without fault of either the student, or the school board, its employees/agents or the facility where the activity is taking place. By choosing to take part in this activity, you are accepting the risk that you/your child may be injured. The chance of an injury occurring can be reduced by carefully following instruction at all times while engaged in the activity.

If you choose to participate in the field trip detailed above, you must understand that you may bear responsibility for any injury that may occur.
