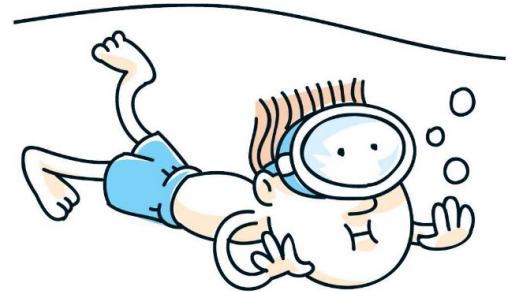

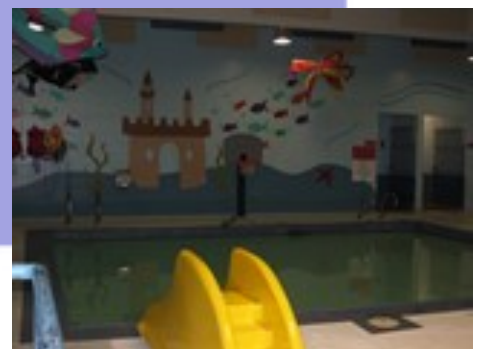

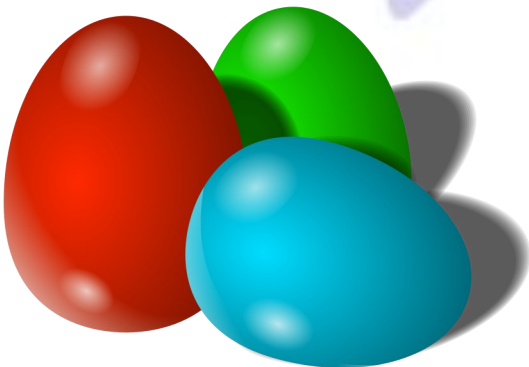


On Thursday, March 17, Grassland Community School students were given a special opportunity to experience the Fine Arts.

Jr. High Basketball Season Comes to a Close



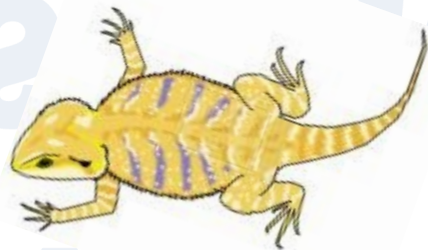
