Hockey Hooky is an annual event hosted by the Edmonton Oil Kings at Rogers Place. Schools from across "Oil Country" in Northern Alberta come together for an afternoon of hockey, education, and fun. The Oil Kings host a WHL hockey game, with a built-in educational component including: student workbooks, in-game educational elements, and additional teaching resources accessible in advance of the game to all participating classrooms.

Grade 5-9 students will be traveling by bus to Rogers Place, Edmonton. On March 12, 2025, the bus will leave at 8:00 a.m. and return at approximately 4:00 p.m. The game starts at 11:00 a.m. **Please make arrangements to bring your child to the school for 8:00 a.m. and pick up your child at the school when the bus returns.** Return time will be communicated to parents that afternoon.

Parents are asked to cover \$20 that includes: game ticket, access to advanced teaching resources, and in-game workbook for all students. The transportation cost will be cover

ELEMENTS OF RISK -

Participation in activities involve certain elements of risk. Injuries may occur while participating in these activities. The following list includes, but is not limited to examples of the types of injury which may result from leaving the school grounds.

1. Pedestrian injuries that may occur while walking along the planned route.
2. Traffic accidents that may occur while traveling roadside along the planned route.
3. Personal injuries that may occur while participating in the activities, such as: dehydration, falling on uneven ground/flooring/steps, bruising, spraining of ankle, broken bones, allergic reactions, burns, etc.

The risk of sustaining these types of injuries result from the nature of the activity and can occur without fault of either the student, or the school board, its employees/agents or the facility where the activity is taking place. By choosing to take part in this activity, you are accepting the risk that you/your child may be injured. The chance of an injury occurring can be reduced by carefully following instruction at all times while engaged in the activity.
